


<u>Comments & Conclusions:</u> Lanes 4, 5 are the test sample Pausinystalia johimbe (RMPJPPAU/2021/06/KAM). Lanes 2, 3, 7, 8, are the reference samples used for comparison. This test sample, Pausinystalia johimbe (RMPJPPAU/2021/06/KAM) is consistent with the chromatographic profile of the reference samples of Pausinystalia johimbe, used above. This test sample Pausinystalia johimbe (RMPJPPAU/2021/06/KAM) has characteristics of Pausinystalia johimbe bark.

NOTE: The above conclusion may be a function of the natural variance found in botanicals &/or the extraction process used to create specific extracts. The growing and drying conditions, age, seasonal variations, geographic location, extraction solvents, etc. all play a role in the phytochemical fingerprint of botanicals as well as their extracts; hence, chromatographic variations are expected.
