

Do I Need a Username and Password to Access CEBS Public Data?

Answer: You do not need a username and password to access CEBS Public Data. For CEBS Data categorized as private, please refer to “Accessing Private CEBS Data” below.

1) Accessing Public CEBS Data

All public data in CEBS is available on the CEBS website and accessible without the need for a username and password (<https://cebs.niehs.nih.gov/cebs/>). Users can search for the data from the CEBS home page for specific studies or data types. After selecting a search result to open the page, users can also use the Download Data button to download all public data.

2) Accessing Private CEBS Data

Some CEBS data are designated as private. For example, recently performed studies that have not been completely reviewed are private until they are released as public in CEBS. Access to private data requires explicit permission from the data owners, the ability to sign in on the NIH Secure Sign In page, and a CEBS account with a username and password.
